REPORT OF TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL - DECEMBER 5, 1973 - 10:00 A.M.
WITH LEGISLATIVE SUB-COMMITTEE MEMBERS OF THE IAC

SUBJ: State Legislation proposals and
Hells Canyon-Snake River National Recreation Area
Bill - Federal - S 2233

House Bill #791: Mr. Francis gave brief resume' of status of this bill; IAC's review and comment concerning it; and reported that Mr. McConnell of Land Use Committee would be making a presentation on the bill at the Dec. 10-11, 1973 IAC meeting in Olympia. It was agreed that staff memorandum in the kit would be called to the attention of the Committee members at the Dec. 10-11 meeting; the Administrator would outline staff concerns and suggestions regarding those segments of the Act which should be further clarified through state agencies input, and IAC position would be to support the bill in general.

House Bill #582 - Rivers': Stan Francis and Lew Bell commented on this bill; outlined its designation of six "instant" rivers, etc. It was the consensus of the Sub-committee on Legislation that this bill be supported as a stepping stone and that IAC go on record to endorse it and lend support to it.

House Bill #87 - Watercraft Marine-Fuel-Tax: Mr. Francis will confer with Representative Alan Thompson on this legislation. He reported on its present status. Suggested it be held for Regular Session at this point. Sub-committee suggested facts be put into the memo on legislation for the kit; committee to discuss.

Init. 215 - amendment re percentages: Following discussion, it was decided Mr. Francis would handle this on informal basis. Mr. Bell suggested getting the Committee to agree that Administrator should handle this matter on the basis of approval by the Sub-Committee on Legislation.

Hells Canyon-Snake River National Recreation Area - S. 2233: General consensus that Sub-Committee on Legislation is in favor of this bill. Stan Francis outlined his visit with Don Moos and interest of Governor Evans in the proposal. Hearing to be held in Idaho will be attended by Mr. Francis who may present the Governor's position statement and that of the IAC. Bishop and Bell suggested

that Mr. Dolliver be contacted concerning the Governor's statement to double-check that he will be supportive of the entire bill. Mr. Francis informed the sub-committee he had checked with Don Moos and had this "in the mill". Mr. Moos had approved of the support; however, the sub-committee asked that Mr. Francis check with Jim Dolliver in Moos' absence prior to Dec. 10 mtg. Memorandum in the kit will cover all of the above legislative items for information of the Committee members, and their action.
