Notes

1. Native American tribes in Washington are eligible.
2. Nonprofit organizations may be eligible. Nonprofits use the population of the jurisdiction where the project is located to determine eligibility.
3. Population density is measured in persons per square mile.
4. The land area measurement excludes lakes and other water areas within.
5. The land area measurements are based on a 1980 survey of cities with changes due to annexations/deannexations/boundary line adjustments made over time. Adjustments to the 1980 values were made in cases where incorrect 1980 data were discovered (Benton City, Brewster, Carnation, Cathlamet, Conconully, Coulee City, Fairfield, La Conner, Lyman, Malden, Pomeroy, Roslyn, Ruston, South Bend, Sultan, Sumner, Westport, and Zillah).
6. For cities that incorporated after 1980, the land area measurements are based on values included in their incorporation documents.
7. Land area declines are due to boundary line adjustments and deannexations.
8. The land measurements presented herein may not match other official records due to differences in base data.
9. The 1980, 1990, 2000, and 2010 population values used to calculate population density represent OFM-adjusted federal census counts. The adjustments include: 1) controlling for annexations occurring between January 1 and April 1 to account for boundary changes related to the timing of the federal census, 2) the substitution of state-certified special census counts in place of federal census counts, and 3) federal corrections to census counts.
10. The City of Winslow changed its name to Bainbridge Island in 1991 following annexation of the entire island in 1990.
