Van Rippers Resort Replacing Guest Moorage

Grant Requested: \$159,600

The Van Rippers Resort, in Sekiu, will use this grant to provide guest moorage for boats larger than 26 feet to the northern part of the Olympic peninsula. The resort will replace 280 feet of docks with moorage docks that will accommodate the larger vessels. Van Rippers Resort will contribute \$56,077. Port of Port Angeles Replacing a Port Angeles Fuel Float

Grant Requested: \$497,320

The Port of Port Angeles will use this grant to replace the marina fueling float at the Port Angeles Boat Haven. The Port will use most of the existing infrastructure at the marina and will replace the fuel float and gangway, which were installed in 1973. Once completed, the project will provide guest and local boaters a reliable and modern fuel facility. The Port of Port Angeles will contribute \$223,433.
