
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STATE LANDS INVENTORY OWNERSHIP, CONTROL AND USE SUMMARY 1970

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INTRODUCTION

In accordance with Chapter 53, Laws of 1969, a reporting system has been developed to provide information on a county level relative to land uses on state-owned or managed lands. This document provides a statistical summary of data obtained from this system.

Forty-seven specific types of land uses are identified in this summary. They are based on land designations presently used in inventory records of state agencies, on terminology commonly used and understood by the general public, and on deliberations by a committee composed of representatives of nine state agencies, including those who collectively own or manage over 95% of all state lands.

Forms developed by the State Lands Inventory Committee were sent to 88 state agencies. Of these, 63 indicated they did not own or manage any state lands. The remaining 25 agencies are responsible for the 3,817,430 acres and 12,747 miles of state lands reported in this document. These totals reflect state inventory records as of July 1, 1970.

The Department of Highways inventory system is in the process of revision, therefore only partial acreage totals were available for Lincoln, Spokane, Stevens, Thurston and Whitman Counties. Mileage figures are complete for all counties.

Capital improvements on the lands are not included as part of this report. All lands are reported in terms of acres, miles, or number of sites. Facilities may be developed on them, but they are not identified in this reporting system.

It should be noted that this summary report relates to lands in terms of total acres or miles used, but not in terms of intensity of use.

By special request of the Governor's Office, estimated valuations of stateowned or managed lands were also developed.
