### **Yakima Building a Swimming Pool**

**Grant Requested: \$5,000,000**

The Yakima Parks and Recreation Department will use this grant to build a swimming pool in east Yakima. A swimming pool was in Martin Luther King Jr. Park in the past but was removed almost 20 years ago due to the aging infrastructure. This project will build a swim lesson and lap pool area, a leisure swimming pool with a zero-depth entry wading area, a spray park area, restrooms, showers, and changing areas. The park is in a community that is underserved in terms of park resources. Yakima will contribute \$5 million cash, grants, and donated cash.
